Main tasks:

- Participate in the research project "No Sword Bites So Fiercly as an Evil Tongue? Gossip Wrecks Reputation, but Enhances Cooperation" (EVILTONGUE), lead by Károly Takács with a focus on two subprojects:
 - 1. Subproject "High Tech Hunt for Secrets"

Task:

- Collection and re-analysis of audio and text material of earlier empirical research on gossip with social network analysis tools.
- 2. Subproject "Gossip in Organizations"

Tasks:

- Participation in the design and organization of the subproject;
- Participation in the practical management of the research, contact management with participating organizations;
- Participation in data collection, processing, and analysis of data;
- Performing supplementary analyses for the subproject.
- Prepare at least one paper or PhD chapter per year in English in collaboration with the Principal Investigator;
- Participate in the preparation of new applications and scientific proposals;
- Participate in other related activities of RECENS (e.g., organization of events).

Criteria of Application:

- MA or MSc degree;
- fluent English both written and oral;
- doctoral student or PhD candidate status;
- clean record, legal capacity.

Advantages:

- the applicant has scientific publications;
- the applicant has experience with the topic of our research;
- the applicant has experience with Social Network Analysis;
- the applicant is familiar with the R statistical environment;
- the applicant has experience in text analytics;
- the applicant graduated in the last 6 years.

The Application shall include:

- a Curriculum Vitae and list of publications;
- a publication, working paper, or a research plan written in English;
- a copy of university diploma.

At the beginning of the employment, a probation period of 4 months will take place.
